The Pepperell Covered Bridge opening celebration was on July 30, 2010. There was a reading by Peter Shattuc written by Peter and Bob Lee about the process that gave us this great new bridge.

Diane Cronin, owner of the Covered Bridge Store, talked about the background of the riders in the first 3 vehicles to ride over the bridge.





After a volley by John Greenwood, representing the First Middlesex Regional Militia, the 2 pickup trucks from Conway Chevy and a car owned by John Masiello of Masy Systems, winner of the first car auction, went over the bridge to officially open it.





The overlook park will have the Prudence Wright memorial, the 1963 Chester Waterous plaque, the sign made from wood from the original bridge, and a kiosk of the history of covered bridges at this site. They hope to have the overlook as ready as possible for the bridge celebration on September 4, 2010.
